**The Old & The New:** We will be having our final Mass in the old church on Tuesday August 18 at 7:00 PM. As part of that celebration we will be having a ritual of closing of the old church and a procession to our new church home that evening. On Sunday August 23 at 9:00 AM we will be celebrating the rite of dedication of our new church home. On the weekend of the dedication we will just have the one Mass celebrated at 9:00 AM. There will be no other Masses that weekend.

**New Mass Schedule:** After the dedication of our new church we will have a change in Mass times. We will go from three Masses each weekend to two.
