Reflection Questions: THE MOST HOLY TRINITY (Proverbs 8:22-31, Romans 5:1-5, John 16:12-15) In the Trinity, all three Persons (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) are equal. Each one is God, yet one is not "more God" than the other. Together, they are one God. Saint Patrick used a shamrock to describe
